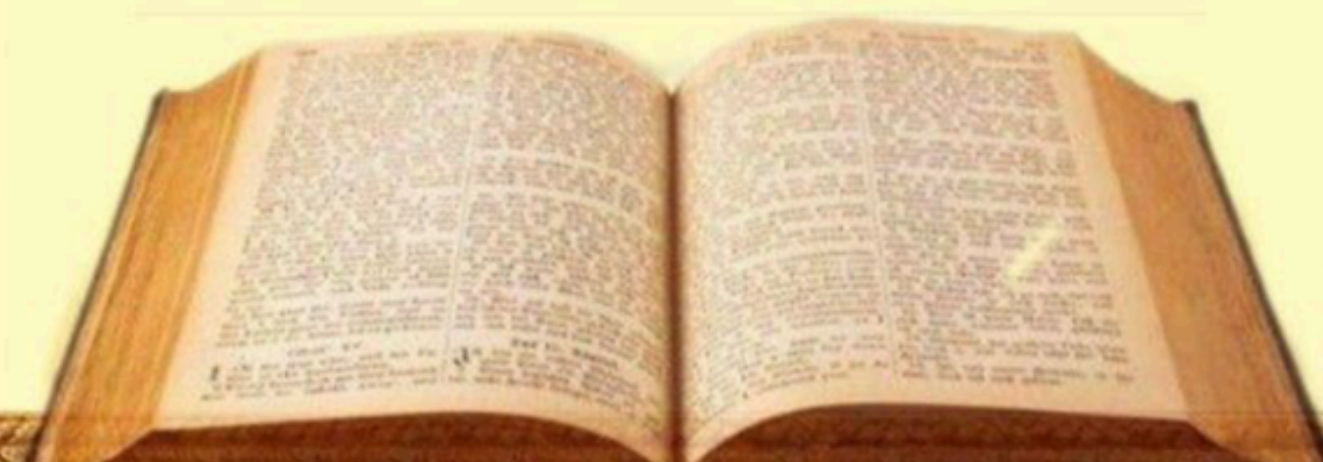
For Example:
