Either mail your completed form to the Board of Elections or return it in person to the Board at 741 Kenilworth Avenue in Charlotte.

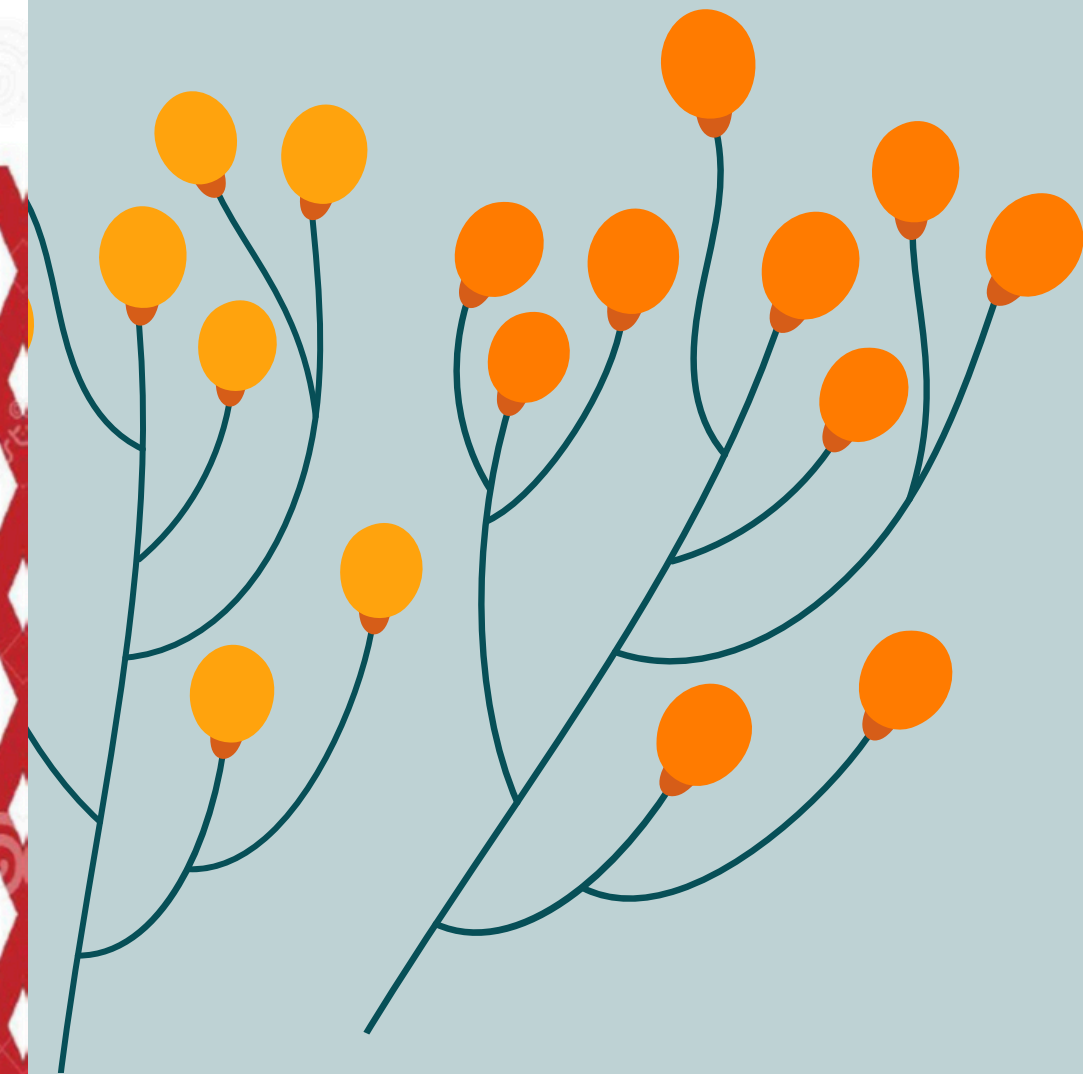
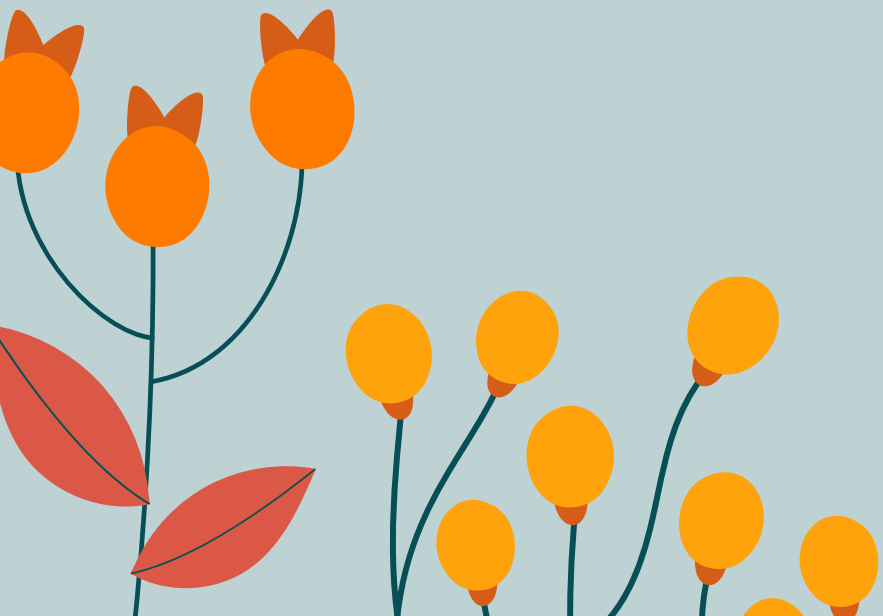

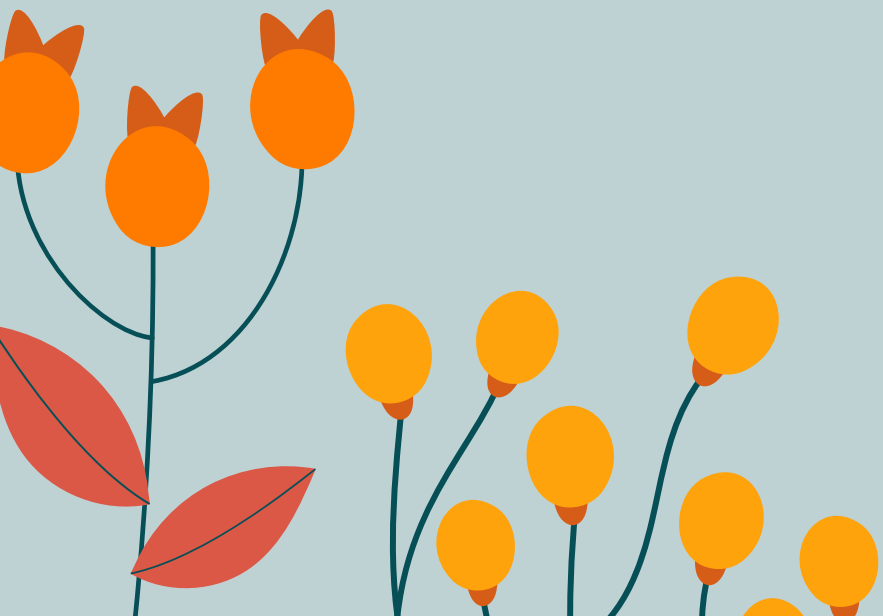
Capital Campaign Update / Homecoming Assessment Request
